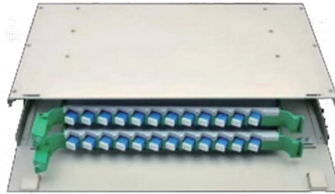


Angled Climbing Bridge



Overview

A skew arch (also known as an oblique arch) is a method of construction that enables an arch bridge to span an obstacle at some angle other than a right angle. This results in the faces of the arch not being perpendicular to its abutments and its plan view being a parallelogram, rather than the rectangle that is the plan view of a regular, or "square" arch. In the case of a masonry skew arch, the arch stones are not a recent invention, having been built on exceptional occasions since times, but they were little understood and rarely used before the advent of the. An early example of the skew arch is the Finlay Bridge, Naas, County Kildare by William Chapman (Kildare Canal, 1787). • Arco Barbara,, Floriana by (1726). • scow arch. •.
