

Are fiber optic patch cords 1 and 2 connected correctly



Overview

Thus, when connecting patchcords, fiber 1 (or the odd numbered fibers) can always go to the transmitter and fiber 2 (or all even numbered fibers) goes to a receiver and proper connectivity is maintained, allowing the use of straight through duplex patch cords. Correct patch-cord installation is essential for maintaining low insertion loss, stable return loss, and long-term reliability in both indoor and outdoor fiber networks. But obviously if you use a straight through patch cable at each end you are linking TX to TX and RX to RX. Another way is to put a switch at Location B and interconnect using SFP modules. But is it possible to connect AB and BC cables using fiber optic patch cords ?

Will it work in this fashion ?
