Overview

Cable trays may be designed to cross through partitions and walls, as well as go vertically through platforms and floors. 2 should be provided in accordance with NEC Section 300. 21 to prevent the spread of a fire or the by-products of combustion. The Unified Facilities Criteria (UFC) system is prescribed by MIL-STD 3007 and provides planning, design, construction, sustainment, restoration, and modernization criteria, and applies to the Military Departments, the Defense Agencies, and the DoD Field Activities in accordance with USD (AT&L).
