Considering the bending radius and safety margin, the final pigtail length is calculated as follows: Straight-line distance: 2 meters Increase in cabling path: 1 meter Interface reserve: 0.5 meters $\times 2 = 1$ meter (one end of each device) Safety margin: 0.5 meters When working with pigtail lights, several calculations must be performed to ensure that the lighting system operates efficiently and safely.
