

Cameroon Telecom Project Aggregation Switch



Overview

The Minister of Post and Telecommunication, Minette Libom Li Likeng, has officially launched the first ever Electronic Communications Aggregation Platform in Cameroon. It is made up of a national switch infrastructure for electronic payment and to enhance the supply of value added services. At the outset of 2022, Cameroon boasted 10.05 million internet users, representing 36.89%. Upon the directive of the President of the Republic through the Prime Minister to rehabilitate the public postal operator, that is the Cameroon Postal Services (CAMPOST) to make it a major instrument of financial and digital inclusion in a bid to transform this company to a space par excellence. The Republic of Cameroon (hereinafter the Recipient) is planning to implement the proposed Acceleration of the Digital Transformation of Cameroon Project (the "Project") for which it has requested a Project Preparation Advance (PPA).
