In many commercial installs, low-voltage cabling may instead run in cable tray, J-hooks, or structured pathways, as long as it's properly supported and compliant. Separating high-voltage power cables from low-voltage communication cables is a fundamental requirement in any electrical installation. This practice is mandatory for two distinct reasons: ensuring the safety of the structure and its occupants, and preserving the integrity of sensitive data. Low voltage cable (also called structured cabling or network wiring) is designed to carry electrical signals of 50 volts or less—significantly lower than the 120V or 240V that runs through standard power outlets.
