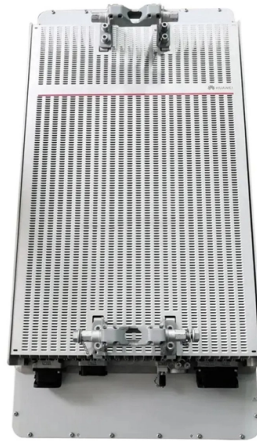


Color Separation Method for Skeleton Optical Cables
