

Distance between the bottom edge of the distribution box and the ground



Overview

While a common recommendation is to position the bottom edge of the distribution cabinet approximately 1. It's important to obtain confirmation from the design unit if adjustments. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure ip67 and the ground should be greater than 1. 8 meters above the ground, which is convenient for operation and inspection. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
