While they serve the common purpose of routing and securing cables, these systems differ in design, application, installation, and. Clause 522-08-04 Where conductors or cables are not supported continuously due to the method of in-stallation, they shall be supported by suitable means at appropriate intervals in such a manner that the conductors or cables do not suffer damage by their own weight.
