Does the Distribution Box Door Need Grounding? Safety Standards FAQ

NEC 250.148 doesn't play favorites: The code mandates that all metallic parts of electrical boxes must bond to ground—no exceptions for cabinet doors. Bottom line: That door is part of the enclosure .

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
