An SFP port is a modular interface on a Gigabit Ethernet switch, router, or server. It accepts SFP or SFP+ transceivers to facilitate data transmission over fiber or copper media. SFP ports provide support for connection types and speeds that are great opportunities for network designers and administrators who are aiming to support performance and. Unlike fixed RJ45 copper ports, SFP ports support both fiber and copper modules, enabling far longer distances, greater flexibility, and improved scalability in enterprise.
