

Fireproof plastic thickness requirements for cable trays



Overview

The gap area between firestop packs and cables should not exceed 1 cm², and the packing thickness should be not less than 24 cm. Select the tray width and thickness according to the number and weight of cables. Ensure mechanical strength is sufficient to prevent deformation or failure under full load. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. us-trations without notice.
