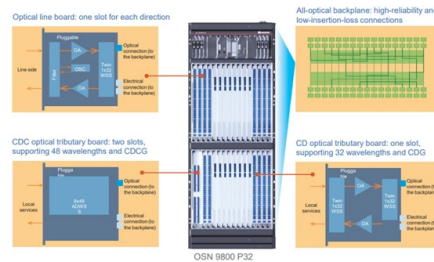


Force the optical port of the 10 Gigabit switch to Gigabit speed



Overview

The proper syntax for forcing a QFX's port speed to gigabit is `link-speed 1g`, see <https://www.net/documentation/us/en/software/junos/interfaces-ethernet-switches/topics/ref/statement/link-speed-interfaces-qfx-series.html> Is it possible to manually change the speed of a ten-gigabit ethernet port on a 4506 switch?

When I go into the interface I am not presented with the "speed" command like I would be on a normal interface. What I would like to do is hard set them to 1gb since the fiber connection is too long to properly. I have available a Juniper QFX5100-48S switch (48 SFP 10G ports, 6 QSFP ports) that I cannot join into our network since an SFP DAC 10G cable connecting it to an SFP port on a HP V1810-48G switch does not work (the web panel on the HP switch says that on the connected port the link is down). Sets a default port mode (access). Specifies a logical unit (unit 0) and assigns it to family ethernet-switching. Configures Storm Control on all 10-Gigabit Ethernet network interfaces. So what happens if it doesn't support 2.5?

Does it just fall back to 1Gbps, or does it just shut the port down?

It does whatever the highest speed both ends can support. If there are no compatible speeds then it doesn't work. I want to wire up certain ports for only 100/10 Mbps speeds, with no support for 1 Gbps. Whereas 1 Gbps (1000BASE-T) uses four differential pairs, 10 and 100 Mbps (10BASE-T and 100BASE-TX) only use two differential pairs. To support only. With the changing transmission rate of Ethernet switch, its port type is also changing, such as SFP port, SFP+ port, SFP28 port, QSFP+ port, QSFP28 port, etc.
