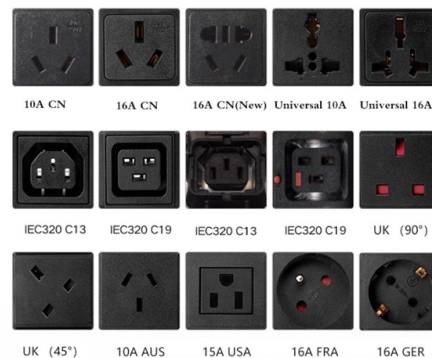


How far should the support be installed at the bend of the cable tray



Overview

Cable supports should be applied at either side of the bend. Where long vertical runs are used (e. in excess of 32 metres), strain relief sections shall be incorporated.

Clause 522-08-04 Where conductors or cables are not supported continuously due to the method of in-stallation, they shall be supported by suitable means at appropriate intervals in such a manner that the conductors or cables do not suffer damage by their own weight.

Cable ladders, cable trays and their supports should be strong enough to meet the load requirements of the cable management system including cables and any future cable additions and any other additional loads applied to the system. Support systems can be broken down into a number of elements or.
