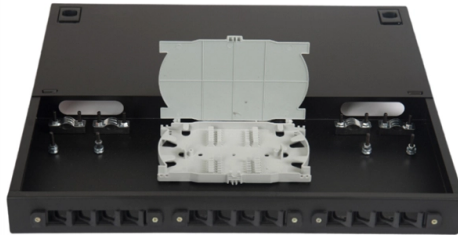


How to connect the cable for cabinet 240

Build an adapter cord to go from 2 120VAC plugs to the 240VAC receptacle that the unit requires. Use color-coded cables—typically black and red for hot lines, and green or bare copper for grounding—to maintain clarity and prevent wiring. The 240 VAC wiring diagram shows the electrical connections and components in a system that uses a 240-volt power supply. You can do this by opening the door to the electrical service panel and flipping the switch that controls the circuit you will.
