EIA-310-D - Defines the official 19-inch rack width, height unit (U) of 1. A rack unit (abbreviated U or RU) is a unit of measure defined as inches (44. [][] It is most frequently used as a measurement of the overall height of 19-inch and 23-inch rack frames, as well as the height of equipment that mounts in these frames, whereby the height of the frame or. Originally defined by the EIA-310 standard, the rack specifies a front panel width of 19 inches (482. 6 mm), allowing different hardware from various manufacturers to fit in the same enclosure. This compatibility has made rackmount systems the backbone of data centers, telecommunications rooms.
