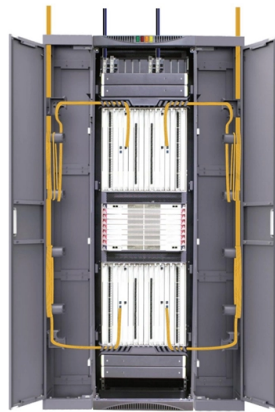


How to turn off the sound from a high-voltage distribution box
