

How was the Gabon fiber optic cable laid



Overview

The infrastructure consists of a 96-strand G652 type fibre optic network laid underground, with a joint box located on the Campo or Ntem River Bridge, in the South Province of Cameroon on Cameroon's borders with Gabon and Equatorial Guinea. A 22km interconnected fibre optic network linking Cameroon and Gabon was recently launched in Meyo-Kye district, Gabon, by senior telecommunications ministers from both West African countries. Gabon is set to establish a dedicated “common vehicle” aimed at advancing the country's fibre optic infrastructure.
