Under the Hazard Communication Standard, secondary containers must display the product identifier and hazard information — through words, pictures, symbols, or any combination that communicates the chemical's dangers to employees. But secondary container labeling can be overlooked or misunderstood. This is because it usually doesn't involve manufacturing or distributing hazardous chemicals.
