Overview

Install fire barriers within the tray to isolate different fire zones. When cable trays pass through walls or floors, seal openings using fire-rated penetration sealing materials. Where cables pass through shafts, walls, slabs, or enter electrical panels or cabinets, openings shall be tightly sealed with firestopping materials in accordance with. For electrical contractors, the installation of fire-resistant cable trays is not just about organizing wires—it's about ensuring safety, regulatory compliance, and long-term reliability. These requirements do not apply to items of switchgear or controlgear installed to facilitate evacuation, such as fire. Segregation of Power and Signal Cables: Power (high-voltage) and signal (low-voltage) cables should be routed separately, using dedicated trays to minimize electromagnetic interference.
