NEC Table 300. 5 for circuits over 120 volts up to 600 volts in general locations: Important: Cover depth is measured from the top of the cable or conduit to finished grade, not from the bottom of the trench. Improper installation creates significant hazards, including shock, fire, and future damage from excavation. Running electricity underground requires.
