Optical cable length limits depend on the interface and fiber type: keep consumer TOSLINK/SPDIF under about 15 m for reliable audio. Some cables reach ~30 m but risk dropouts. Treat ADAT/Lightpipe conservatively unless your gear specifies longer spans. The LC connector is a miniaturized version of the SC connector, featuring a 1. It uses a latch mechanism similar to an RJ45 plug, offering secure connections in tight spaces. LC connectors have become the go-to standard in modern data.
