SFP+ stands for “Small Form-Factor Pluggable Plus” and it's a type of hot-pluggable transceiver that supports data rates up to 10 gigabits per second (Gbps). It can transmit high-speed data over short distances, with a maximum transmission distance of up to 300 meters. Typically used in higher-speed connections between switches and servers or as the primary interface. Small form-factor pluggable modules for 10 Gigabit Ethernet (10GE) connectivity are called 10G SFP transceiver technology. They can be plugged in and out while. The IEEE 802.
