

# What type of wire should be used when connecting a power distribution box on a construction site

Wire color: The neutral wire is blue, and the color of the phase wire (A phase is yellow, B phase is green, and C phase is red) should meet the standard. Necessary materials include an electrical enclosure, expansion bolts, fixing brackets, screws, terminal blocks, qualified wires, cable ties, insulating tape, etc. Necessary personal protective equipment also can't be ignored.
