

Wiping the end face of the fiber optic connector



Overview

A click-type cleaner uses a clean fabric ribbon that advances with each click, wiping the connector end-face in a single pass. These are effective for both patch cord connectors and bulkhead adapters when used with the correct tip attachment. Clean fiber optic connectors (like SFP or QSFP connectors) ensure low insertion loss, stable signal integrity, and long-term reliability. However, contaminants such as dust, oil, and residue are almost unavoidable during installation, patching, or maintenance. A fifth family includes electrical bench-top cleaners.
